Minnesota Legislation Updated May 1, 2023

SIGNED INTO LAW:

April 27, 2023

• Governor Walz signed the **Reproduction Freedom Defense Act (HF366/SF165)** into law on April 27, 2023. This law protects and invites abortionists who have had their licenses taken away in another state, effectively making Minnesota a sanctuary state for abortionists.

January 31, 2023

 Governor Walz signed the Protect Reproductive Actions (PRO Act) into law on January 31st, making abortion until birth legal. This makes our state among the worst in the nation and aligns with China and North Korea in failing to provide protections for the unborn or women seeking abortion.

UPCOMING BILLS:

- **Reproduction Freedom Codification Act (HF91/SF70):** Removes the abortion reporting requirement, repeals the Born Alive Infant Protection Act, allows abortions to be committed at birthing centers, greatly expands taxpayer funding of abortion, and more.
- **Positive Pregnancy Support Act (HF289/SF336):** Completely changes the Positive Alternatives Act so Pregnancy Resource Centers do not qualify for grant funds, but proabortion organizations receive the funds.
- **HF3/SF3:** Prevents anyone from exposing a candidate's voting record near an election
- **HF1170**: Would increase medical assistance reimbursement rates solely for abortion and abortion-related services
- **HF174/SF662:** directs students to Planned Parenthood and other abortion businesses for information and referral, and away from pro-life pregnancy care centers
- HF2930 Omnibus bill that takes all of the abortion bills and puts it into one bill
